
NOTICE



The recommendations of the Budget Committee and the estimated property tax mill rate for the 2002-2003 Budget (July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003) contained herein, are preliminary and tentative only, and do not represent the final recommendations of the Board of Estimate and Taxation, which will be included in the Proposed Budget to be passed upon by the Representative Town Meeting on May 13, 2002.

Public Hearings on the various items of the Budget will be held in the Town Hall Meeting Room on Monday, March 25, and Tuesday, March 26 as determined by the Board of Estimate and Taxation. Notices of the Departments assigned each day are posted in the Town Clerk's Office. Also, call the Finance Department 622-7720 for Public Hearing information.

Copies of the Public Notice of the Public Hearings, as approved by the Board of Estimate and Taxation, will be delivered to all members of the Representative Town Meeting and the Heads of Departments. Copies of this document will be available in the office of the Comptroller to all persons interested.

The Budget Committee requests all members of the Representative Town Meeting, especially standing committee members, and all interested taxpayers and citizens attend the Public Hearings and give the Board of Estimate and Taxation the benefit of their views. This request is made so that issues may be highlighted and discussed at that time and not advanced for the first time in Town Meeting after the proposed Budget has been prepared by a the Board of Estimate and Taxation.

The Budget Committee wishes to express its appreciation for the cooperation of all Town of Greenwich Departments.
