INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AND SIGNAL
REVISION

Town Project No. 13-18

GREENWICH, CONNECTICUT – The TOWN of Greenwich has a project for the reconfiguration of the existing traffic island and signal revision. Preliminary design has been completed and the project is slated for construction under the Local Road Accident Reduction Program administered by the Connecticut Department of Transportation.

It is the Town of Greenwich's and the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation's policy to keep the public informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. It is important that the community share its concerns with us to assist in the project's development.

The Town will conduct a public informational meeting on Thursday, March 27, 2014 at 7:00 P.M., at the Greenwich Town Hall, 101 Field Point Road, Greenwich, CT 06830, in the Mazza Room, on the First Floor.

Based upon a preliminary assessment, the construction cost will be approximately \$314,000.00. The Federal Highway Administration will provide 90% of the construction cost and the Town will provide 10%.
