

## INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids will be received at the Office of the Purchasing Agent and will be opened and read aloud in the Engineering Conference Room, Town Hall, 101 Field Point Road, Greenwich, Connecticut at 200 P.M. on Thursday, January 31, 2013 for the following work:

**South Water Street Pump Station and Gravity Sewer  
Town of Greenwich, Connecticut  
Project No. 11-5317  
Contract No. 5317**

A certified check or bond for five percent (5%) of the bid must accompany each bid. All such checks except those of the three lowest bidders, will be returned within five (5) days after the bids are opened.

Bidders may be required to submit data covering financial resources, equipment and ability to perform the work rapidly and in a satisfactory manner.

The right is expressly reserved to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in the bids, or to accept such bids as appear to be in the best interest of the Town.


Bidders' attention is made to the front end requirements contained in Division 0 of this Project Manual. Instructions given shall be followed and all required forms shall be submitted. The Town of Greenwich will strictly enforce these requirements.

Bidders shall complete the Vendor Information & Signatory Form for all Contracts equal to or in excess of \$250,000.00. Failure to complete the Vendor Information & Signatory Form, located in Section 2, will cause the contractors bid to be disqualified.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed, insurance coverage requirements and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

Drawings and specifications may be obtained at the office of the Department of Public Works, Sewer Division, Town Hall, 101 Field Point Road, Greenwich, Connecticut. There will be a non-refundable fee of \$75 for each set of drawings and specifications requested. Fee must be paid with check or money order; cash and credit cards are not accepted.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM on Thursday January 10, 2013 at the Grass Island Waste Water Treatment Plant, Greenwich, CT, with a site visit to South Water Street to follow. Representatives of the Town and the Engineer will be present to discuss the project. Attendance of this conference is not required, but highly recommended. A transmittal to all prospective bidders in the form of an addendum will be distributed as a response to any pertinent questions raised at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.
