

Batteries (Lead Acid-Auto) shall mean any electricity producing system of lead plates and dilute sulfuric acid; used as a starter battery and as a traction battery in electric vehicles or as a source for lights because they are rechargeable, inexpensive, and durable.

RESTRICTIONS:

- * No 'out-of-town' batteries. All waste batteries delivered to the Holly Hill facility MUST have been generated within the Town of Greenwich.
- * Out of Town businesses working for Greenwich residents or Greenwich businesses MUST have a signed and dated verification letter from the Greenwich resident or Greenwich business for any batteries delivered. See sample [Verification of Owner Form](#).
- * DO NOT bring batteries to Household Hazardous Waste Collection day.

FEES:

- * \$0.00 There is no charge for batteries from residential/commercial sources.

Where is the Lead-Acid (Auto) Battery drop-off area?

On the Operations Field, next to the Construction Debris area. The Operations Field is at the bottom of the hill, across from the Trash Transfer Building. An attendant will place the battery in the auto battery storage container.
