

Fluorescent light bulbs shall mean any lamp that produces visible light by fluorescence, especially a glass tube whose inner wall is coated with a material that fluoresces when an electrical current causes a vapor within the tube to discharge electrons. This includes Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFLs) which are the smaller spiral shaped bulbs.

RESTRICTIONS:

- * No 'out-of-town' fluorescent light bulbs. All waste fluorescent light bulbs delivered to the Holly Hill facility MUST have been generated within the Town of Greenwich.
- * Out of Town businesses working for Greenwich residents or Greenwich businesses MUST have a signed and dated verification letter from the Greenwich resident or Greenwich business for each load delivered. See sample [Verification of Owner form](#).
- * Ballasts with PCBs are NOT accepted.
- * Bulbs/Lamps MUST be separated from light fixtures upon delivery to the Holly Hill Facility
- * NO businesses with large quantities. The Holly Hill Facility fluorescent light bulbs recycling services are intended for residents and small businesses with reasonable quantities of used fluorescent light bulbs.
- * BROKEN bulbs are NOT accepted.

FEES:

- * \$0.00 There is no charge for fluorescent light bulbs from residential/commercial sources.

Where is the fluorescent light bulb drop-off area?

On the Operations Field, next to the attendant's shed. The Operations Field is at the bottom of the hill, across from the Trash Transfer Building.
