

***Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)*** shall mean solid waste from residential, commercial and industrial sources, EXCLUDING solid waste consisting of significant quantities of hazardous waste as defined in section CGS [22a-115](#), land-clearing debris, demolition debris, biomedical waste, sewage sludge and scrap metal; is sometimes also defined as trash, garbage or refuse in the vernacular.

***Trash*** shall mean materials which prior to being discarded, were not acceptable in current recycling and mandatory recycling programs which include but are not limited to non-recyclable fiber (paper wrappers & rags) small pieces of wood (e.g. wooden picture frame), garbage, non-recyclable plastic (food wrappers). PLEASE NOTE that “small pieces of wood” does not mean wooden construction & demolition debris.

***Garbage*** shall mean every accumulation of animal, vegetable or other matter that attends the preparation, consumption, decay, dealing in or storage of meats, fish, fowl, birds, fruit, vegetables, beverages or other edibles, including the non-recyclable containers or wrappers disposed of along with such materials.

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- \* No ‘out-of-town’ trash or garbage. All trash or garbage delivered to the Holly Hill facility MUST have been generated within the Town of Greenwich.
- \* MUST NOT contain recyclables, construction and demolition debris, yard waste/logs, scrap metal, hazardous waste, electronics, air conditioners/refrigerators/dehumidifiers (CFC containing items), tires, fluorescent bulbs, batteries (all types), American flags.

**FEES:**

\$0.00 There is no charge for residential or commercial trash or garbage.

**Where is Trash drop off area?**

In the Trash Transfer Station building at the bottom of the hill, on the left side of the road. The building is across from the Operations Field.
