

**Single Stream Recyclables (SSR)** shall mean those solid wastes which are caused to be separated from other solid wastes for the purposes of processing, marketing and eventual remanufacture and/or reuse, BUT which go beyond the requirements of the law. Beyond the mandated recyclable materials, Single Stream incorporates recyclable materials that, in the past, had the potential to be recycled but were not (except in some special programs). **Recyclables** shall mean those solid wastes which are caused to be separated from other solid wastes for the purposes of processing, marketing and eventual remanufacture and/or reuse. Mandatory Recyclables include both residentially and commercially generated newspaper (ONP), Mixed Paper (MP), Corrugated Cardboard (OCC), glass, metal and select plastic food and beverage containers (Commingled), Scrap Metal, Automotive Batteries, Waste Motor Oils, Leaves, Nickel-Cadmium, as designated by the State or Town of Greenwich as defined in the Town Code §8a. **PLEASE NOTE that although the following items are mandated recyclables, large pieces of Scrap Metal, Automotive Batteries, Waste Motor Oil, Leaves, and Nickel-Cadmium Batteries MUST NOT be included in your Single Stream Recycling collection.**

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- \* No 'out-of-town' recyclables. All recyclables delivered to the Holly Hill facility **MUST** have been generated within the Town of Greenwich.
- \* **MUST NOT** contain trash/garbage, construction and demolition debris, yard waste/logs, oversized pieces of scrap metal, hazardous waste, electronics, CFC containing items, tires, fluorescent bulbs, batteries, clothe or clothing, wood, [mixed-material items](#), food contaminated items (e.g. soiled plastic wrap), paper napkins/towels.

**FEES:**

\$0.00 There is no charge for recyclables or single stream recyclables from residential or commercial sources.

**Where is Recycling area?**

Is a right turn off the entrance road to the Holly Hill Facility. The recycling drop-off is just after the Goodwill donations trailer.
