

Waste motor oil shall mean any [oil](#) formerly used for [lubrication](#) of various [internal combustion engines](#).

Waste anti-freeze shall mean any liquid, usually ethylene glycol (ethanediol), added to cooling water to lower its freezing point, especially for use in an internal-combustion engine.

RESTRICTIONS:

- * No 'out-of-town' waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze. All waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze delivered to the Holly Hill facility MUST have been generated within the Town of Greenwich.
- * Out of Town businesses working for Greenwich residents or Greenwich businesses MUST have a signed and dated verification letter from the Greenwich resident or Greenwich business for any batteries delivered. See sample [Verification of Owner Form](#) .
- * NO leaking containers, NO sealed plastic bags and NO GLASS jars.
- * NO diesel, NO gasoline, NO OTHER petroleum products
- * NO hazardous wastes or paints
- * DO NOT bring waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze to Household Hazardous Waste Collection day.

FEES:

- * \$0.00 There is no charge for waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze from residential/commercial sources.

Where are the waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze drop-off areas?

On the YELLOW drip pallet, across the road from the scale house. The scale house is on the entrance road to the Holly Hill Facility. **DO NOT POUR waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze into the drip pallet.** If you want your waste motor oil or waste anti-freeze transport container back, please tell the scale house attendant and be prepared to wait up to 15 minutes.
