Keep recyclables loose – do **not** box, bag or bundle.

## NEW RULES FOR RECYCLING

Effective July 1, 2018

These have been developed to reduce problems in processing & to avoid contamination.

Three main materials no longer accepted are:

<b>PLASTIC BAGS</b>	Take clean plastic bags & film to participating stores
<b>SHREDDED PAPER</b>	Bagged shreds can be deposited in special container at Holly Hill
<b>STYROFOAM</b>	Trash
