SESSION 3: July 22-August 2

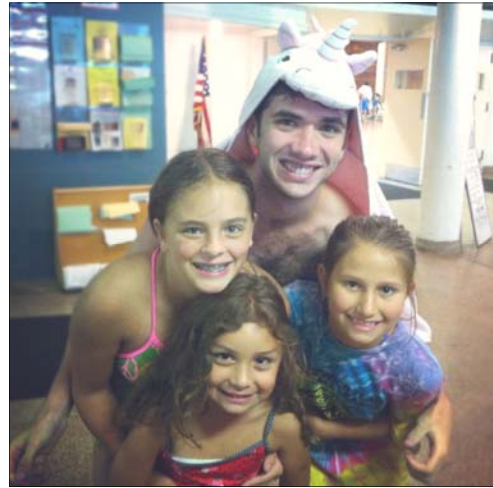

Kamp Kairphree operates at the Civic Center and at Greenwich Point Beach, simultaneously. Campers are bussed between these locations.



One field trip per session may require a signed permission slip. With your permission, campers will go to the movies, ice-skating, and more!

Special events are also held here at the Civic Center throughout the summer. In previous years we have welcomed Danny Magic, a popular Italian ices cart, and waterslide events!



On both regular days and on field trip days, a bag lunch must be brought from home. Drinks are provided.

Campers will be sorted into units by age on the first day of each session. Units of similar ages will travel and play together. Camper to counselor ratio is approx 4:1.

Our daily routine consists of a rotating schedule. All campers come to the Civic Center in the mornings (**Except Wednesdays, read on!**).

From there, some will travel to the “front” of the beach, and some to the “back.” Those campers at the beach will swap sides at lunchtime.



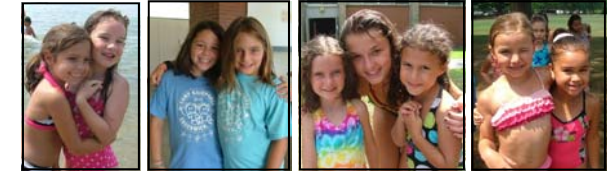
In addition to lots of swimming and free beach time, there are also group games, activities, and arts & crafts! Older campers may also participate in overnights.

Wednesdays are special here at Kamp Kairphree! All campers go directly to Island Beach pier and take the ferry to spend the full day there. They do not come to the Civic Center at all on Wednesdays unless there is inclement weather. **Always call the hotline, it will be updated daily!**



On rain days, special accommodations are made to keep all campers at the Civic Center. Our camp has full use of all the rooms at the center as well as the entire field and two playgrounds, assuring lots of room for all of our campers to play.

One session always hosts our annual Kamp Kairphree Olympics! Competitions, Banners, Tug-o-War at the beach, and a big cookout!



Registration begins by mail only, April 15th, 2013. All incomplete registrations, or those postmarked before the 15th, will be returned. In-person registration begins May 6th. Forms returned without a completed medical, from Sept. 1st, 2011 or after, will not be accepted. Birth certificates are required for 5 yr olds only. Registration is limited and available on a first-come first-served basis. Payment is due in full at the time of registration. Fees are: \$250 per session for the first child, \$240 for each additional sibling in the same session, \$285 per child for non-residents. No refunds. There will be a \$25 fee for any returned checks. All completed registration forms should be mailed to the Civic Center.

Non-resident forms will be held until one week prior to the beginning of the requested session. Regular daily transportation is included in the camp fee. Schedule of pick-up points is available in the registration packet. All campers must know the name and location of their bus stop, as well as their address and phone number. **Campers should bring a bathing suit, towel, water shoes, and spray-on sunscreen daily.** Please label all your child’s belongings. Electronics may not be brought to camp (i.e. cell phone, Nintendo DS, etc). We are not responsible for valuables brought to camp.
