**EAST PUTNAM AVENUE PHASE II DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS
TOWN PROJECT NUMBER 09-17**

GREENWICH, CONNECTICUT – The Town of Greenwich, Department of Public Works, Engineering Division will be managing construction to improve the drainage system in your area, specifically down the center of East Putnam Avenue between Church Street and Sherwood Place. This project involves the installation of a storm drain on East Putnam Avenue. This project will be completed during the night time hours of 7 pm and 5 am so that commuter traffic, businesses and residents in the area will have less interruption. The proposed construction is to commence on Monday, May 22nd and is estimated to last 3 months, dependent on the weather and any unknowns.

The Contractor, Coastline Construction Corp., anticipates starting construction on East Putnam Avenue, at Church Street/Mason Street and install pipe toward Sherwood Place. The work area will be mostly at the center of the road, so the parking lane will be used as a travel lane in both directions during construction.

Besides drainage pipe replacement, curbing will be replaced in several locations, various catch basins and manholes will be installed, and East Putnam Avenue will be entirely repaved and fresh pavement markings will be applied. The Town may be completing sidewalk maintenance after completion of the drainage, either Fall 2017 or Spring 2018 under a separate contract.

Prior to working in a specific area, the street will be posted with “NO PARKING BETWEEN 6 PM AND 6 AM” signs. Please take notice of the posted signs in the Town’s right-of-way to be sure that you and your customers/tenants park your vehicles elsewhere. Any vehicles that are not moved will be towed.

It is the Town’s policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. The Engineering Division of the Department of Public Works along with CDM Smith Inc. will be working together to make sure you are informed and aware of what is happening.
