Play golf at the only non-private golf course in Greenwich. The Town of Greenwich owns a championship golf course named the Griffith E. Harris Golf Course also referred to as "The Griff" located at 1323 King Street. The Griff is an award winning 18-hole, Robert Trent Jones designed course built in 1964 where Greenwich residents and guests have an affordable place to enjoy the game since every other course in Town is private and costly. The Griff is recognized as one of the premier golf courses in the area and has hosted an official PGA professional event. In an article it published about the course, Greenwich Magazine referred to The Griff as Greenwich's "hidden gem".

While the course is of championship caliber, each hole has four sets of tees to accommodate golfers of all abilities. Practice areas include a driving range, putting green and chipping area with a sand trap. We also have a full service restaurant (Fairways at The Griff) and a Pro Shop with a resident Pro and assistants that are available for lessons along with a full range of golfing supplies and clothing on the premises. Further, there are four very active men's and lady's golf clubs who play at The Griff.
