The Greenwich Police Department is accepting applications for the Spring 2017 Citizen's Police Academy Class. The 6 week session will commence on Tuesday April 25, 2017 and meet twice a week from 6:30 - 9:00 p.m. (Tuesdays and Thursdays) \* Graduation will be held on Tuesday June 6, 2017.

The Citizen's Police Academy is a program that provides Greenwich residents with a first hand overview of the law enforcement and community related functions of the Greenwich Police Department.

Instructors for the program will be highly trained and experienced Greenwich Police Officers. There is no fee for the six week program. \* Any Greenwich resident or person employed in Greenwich 18 years of age or older may apply. Seating will be limited to 40 persons.

**Due to the high demand of this class, qualified applicants will be subject to a lottery drawing to determine the class roster.**

\* One Saturday Session is scheduled for May 20th (9:30 am to 1:30pm) - Hours are subject to change. **SRU Demonstration**

\*\*Applicants must be Greenwich residents or employed in Greenwich and should attempt to attend each class of instruction.
