



PARK / BEACH ACCESS AND PARKING 2017

****Resident Vehicle Parking stickers will not be issued this year****

How do vehicles get into the park/beach at all times during the season May 1 – October 31, 2017?

- If a current Resident Season pass holder is in vehicle, nothing further for the vehicle is required. (Except out of state and non-Greenwich Taxed vehicles; see bullet below). If none of the occupants is a current Resident Season pass holder, a single entry Parking Pass is required.
- Out of State and Non Greenwich Taxed Vehicle: A Single Entry Parking Pass or a Resident Vehicle permit with current Resident Season Park pass holder is required.

How do I park at the Arch Street parking lot when going on the ferry June 10 – September 16, 2017?

- During the summer ferry season an attendant will monitor the Ferry designated area in the parking lot at Arch St.
- Only vehicles with Ferry passengers will be allowed to park in the Ferry designated area which will open at 9:30 AM weekdays.
- A vehicle parking in the Ferry designated area must pay for parking at the parking kiosk or have a current Resident Season Park pass holder (with a Resident Vehicle permit if the vehicle is not taxed in Greenwich).

How do people get into the park/beach during the season May 1 – October 31, 2017?

- Between the hours of 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM every person 5 years or older regardless of how they enter must have a current Resident Season Park pass or a Single Entry Park Pass.
- All other times a current Resident Season Park Pass or Single Entry Park Pass is not required.

How do I renew/apply for a Resident Seasonal Park Pass?

- All Resident Season Park passes are for named resident only and are not transferable.

Where can I purchase Single Entry Park passes and Single Entry Parking passes?

- Single Entry Park Passes and Single Entry Parking Passes will be sold at:
 - Eastern Greenwich Civic Center: M-F 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM May 1 – October 31

 - Western Greenwich Civic Center: M-F 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM May 1- September 15

 - Payments accepted: Cash, Visa, MasterCard and Discover
- Residents can purchase Single Entry Park and Single Entry Parking passes on line at: www.greenwichct.org/webtrac
 - Required proof of residency must be submitted to and approved by the P&R department for the current calendar year.
 - Passes must be printed in advance and presented at the gate.
- Single Entry Park and Single Entry Parking passes are not sold at Town Hall

How do I get into the Holly Hill Resource Recovery Facility?
